

## **Transitions**

### **Programme Content**

Transitions is a free 7-week Parenting programme targeted at mothers, fathers, grandparents and any other adults who have responsibility for caring for:

- A Y6 child or has had a poor attendance at primary school and is concerned about the transition to secondary school
- A Y6 child who parents fear may struggle with the transition into secondary school
- A Y7 child who is finding the transition into secondary school difficult.

It is a free programme and delivered by the Attendance Development Team.
